

Strickland Farms

The Strickland Farms development was built in the early to mid-1990s and is a mixture of one-level condos and townhouses that offer full basements. Some have 9-foot ceilings on the first floor. Strickland Farms offers many amenities, including an indoor and outdoor pool, sauna, fitness center, tennis court, and clubhouse. Michael Tighe Park and Turkey Swamp Park are a short distance away, and Freehold Raceway Mall and Strickland Farms is just off Route 9 near Woolley's Fish Market, making commuting or traveling to area beaches convenient. If you live in the Strickland Farms neighborhood, your children will attend Marshall W. Errikson Elementary School Dwight D. Eisenhower Middle School, and Freehold High School. Freehold High School is one of six schools that comprise the Freehold Regional High School District. The FRHSD is a highly-rated public school allowing students to apply for specialized magnet and International Baccalaureate programs.
