

Turnbury Estates

Turnbury Estates is a neighborhood located in East Freehold. The development was built in 2003 and includes 17 homes. The Colonial-style homes offer open floor plans, two-story foyers, four to five bedrooms, and two to three-car garages. The properties are spacious, including an acre or more, all with public utilities. The community sits near Route 33 and Route 537, providing easy access to major highways, shopping, NYC transportation, and the Jersey Shore Beaches. Freehold High School is one of six schools that comprise the Freehold Regional High School District.
