Whittier Oaks

The Whittier Oaks neighborhood was built in the 1970's and are mostly 3-5 bedroom colonials but there are a few ranch style homes. The homes typically have a basement and 2 car garage. Living in Whittier Oaks offers easy access to Route 9 and 33, shopping, beaches and three parks closeby: Opatut Park, Lake Topanemus Park, Whittier Oaks Park.

If you live in the Whittier Oaks neighborhood your children will attend Applegate Elementary School, which is located right in the neighborhood, Dwight D. Eisenhower Middle School and Freehold High School.

Freehold High School is one of six schools that comprise the Freehold Regional High School District. The FRHSD is a highlyrated public school allowing students to apply for specialized magnet and International Baccalaureate programs.
