Juniper Farms is a neighborhood of 258 homes built in 1967 in an assortment of architectural styles from ranches to split and bi-levels to colonials. They range from 3-5 bedrooms with 2-4 bathrooms. Some of the homes have been renovated with additions up to 3,000 sq ft.

Many of the homes back to wooded areas and offer a basement. Living in Juniper Farms offers easy access to Route 9 and 33, shopping, beaches, Sargent Park and recently built Taco Bell, Chick-Fil-A, WaWa and Tropical Smoothie Cafe.
