The homes in this subdivision were built in 1989 to 1991. They have 2,000 to 2,200 square foot floorplans with three to four bedrooms and up to four bathrooms. Custom cabinets, wood floors, and stainless steel appliances are common, as are ceiling fans and ample overhead lighting. The homes offer off-street parking, driveways and single car garages.

With the Old Bridge Township Raceway Park right to the north of the neighborhood, residents always have somewhere to attend automotive and motorcycle events. 30 to 60 minutes north or east residents can reach the breathtaking ocean beaches along Raritan Bay. Brooklyn Pizza and the Manalapan Luncheonette are close by.

If you live in BriarHeath your children will attend Milford Brook Elementary, Manalapan-Englishtown Middle School and Freehold Township High School. Freehold High School is one of six schools that comprise the Freehold Regional High School District. The FRHSD is a highly-rated public school allowing students to apply for specialized magnet and International Baccalaureate programs.
