Forest Hills

Along the western side of Bucks Head Park is the quiet Forest Hills neighborhood. The single-family ranch style homes in this subdivision were built in 1989.

This neighborhood features single-family homes with 1,200 to 1,500 square foot floorplans. Their layouts have up to three bedrooms and two bathrooms along with spacious living rooms and dining areas. They are on ½ to ½ acre lots with mature trees and beautiful garden beds. The residences come with both on and off-street parking, though many do not have garages.

Forest Hills is also near Monmouth Battlefield State Park. At this greenspace, everyone can view the restored Revolutionary War battlefield and explore the many meandering trails. Closer to the neighborhood, there is Bucks Head Park, which has basketball courts, open fields, and a playground.

Forest Hills is just off Union Hill Road making the trip to Route 9 and Route 18 convenient. Mom's golden Griddle, LaRosa Chicken & Grille and Bonefish Grill are some of the nearby restaurant choices for this neighborhood.

If you live in Forest Hills your children will attend Milford Brook Elementary, Manalapan-Englishtown Middle School and Freehold Township High School. Freehold High School is one of six schools that comprise the Freehold Regional High School District. The FRHSD is a highly-rated public school allowing students to apply for specialized magnet and International Baccalaureate programs.
