

Manalapan Hills

The Manalapan Hills subdivision lies along the western edge of Millhurst Pond and Thompson Grove Park in New Jersey. This neighborhood features single-family homes in a wide variety of architectural styles. Constructed from 1988 to 2001, the single-family homes in this community range from 3,500 to 5,900 square feet. Their layouts have four to five bedrooms and up to six bathrooms plus large shared living spaces.

Thompson Grove Park where people come from near and far to walk the trails and take in the beautiful sights is nearby. A bit further to the north, residents can find Monmouth Battlefield State Park, which offers miles of trails to explore. When everyone wants to go shopping, they just head toward the Freehold Raceway Mall and the many other shopping centers closely. If you live in Manalapan Hills your children will attend Wemrock Brook Elementary, Manalapan-Englishtown Middle School and Freehold Township High School. Freehold High School is one of six schools that comprise the Freehold Regional High School District. The FRHSD is a highly-rated public school allowing students to apply for specialized magnet and International Baccalaureate programs.
