The Knolls

The Knolls neighborhood are single-family homes built from 1960 to 1974. The single-family homes in this community have floorplans ranging from 1,300 to 2,400 square feet. Their layouts have up to three bathrooms and four bedrooms. The homes have large ½ to ½ acre properties covered in lush, green grass and mature trees.

Right in the neighborhood, residents have Knolls Playground, which features a full-size basketball court surrounded in open fields. Other parklands in their midst includes Monmouth Battlefield State Park, Perrineville Lake Park, and James Monroe Memorial Park. Located just south of Route 33, it is a short drive to Peking Pavillion, Freehold Raceway Mall and the NJ Turnpike to the west.

If you live in The Knolls your children will attend Wemrock Brook Elementary, Manalapan-Englishtown Middle School and Freehold Township High School. Freehold High School is one of six schools that comprise the Freehold Regional High School District. The FRHSD is a highly-rated public school allowing students to apply for specialized magnet and International Baccalaureate programs.
